ACTIONS:

1. Re-Opening Plan: Marsha presented some of the re-opening plan details to the board. It includes a Mon/Wed and Tues/Thurs hybrid schedule. There would be 20-21 kids in the school at one time, keeping kids 6ft apart at all times. Kids will be required to wear masks all day, except recess if they remain 6ft apart. They need to bring their own masks. Kids will have lunch with their family members to minimize exposure. When kids are dropped off there will be temp checks before they exit their vehicle as well as a parent attestation for each child. A temp of 100.4 disqualifies anyone for attendance. We have new portable washing stations and we will supply 2 refillable water bottles for each child. There will be no use of the water fountain allowed. Each child will keep their own supplies in their individual desk. Lunch will continue to be on the summer program through the rest of this school year. Vincent Reese will be starting a full time schedule in order to maximize cleaning and disinfecting needs starting the 1st day kids come back to school in person. February 1st, 2021 is the tentative reopening date as long as the health department and our government allows. A motion was made by Shawna Williams to approve the re-opening plan. The motion was seconded by Darlene Reynolds. Motion carried.
